Be ALERT to

- *Strong, gusty winds, especially overnight
- *Very Low Humidity. <20) Severe Drought Conditions
- *Wildfire Danger: **High to Extreme**



Be PREPARED

- *Clean chimneys **AND** spark arresters
- *Maintain 30' Defensible Space around home
- *Reflective address signage; emergency numbering (707-462-1085 \$6.00 incl. delivery)
- *Examine home heating systems for safety
- *Fireplaces, space heaters, central heating; change out air filters
- *Maintain wide driveway access to accommodate firetrucks, emergency vehicles
- *Train children in safety precautions

WATCH OUT FOR

- *Candles and incense
- *Sparks from fireplace
- *Faulty wiring on Christmas decorations
- *Overloaded extension cords
- * Dry Christmas trees and scattered Christmas wrappings
