Disposing of Dry Brush Piles

Consider heaps of dry slash, logs,
brush as impending fire risks.

Embers from a wildfire can easily ignite
these exposed piles.

One option for disposal : Haul to North
Grand Transfer Station (Airport Rd.)

FIRST Obtain a "Land fill" account # at
City of Las Vegas Utilities Office at
1335 1st St (across from Golf Course
on Mills Ave.) Cost: \$10.50 pick-up
truck load; \$20. Trailer load (plus
weight approx. 3 cents lb.)

Take to Transfer Station located at 35
Aragon Rd. (N. Grand /turn right on
Airport Rd., Rt turn, cross RR tracks,
down to Transfer Station.)

Hours: 7:30 AM-3:30 M-F; 9:00-12 PM
Saturday.

Call 505-426-0350 to make sure they
have room for your load

No trash, No stumps. Branches not
longer than 6 ft.; diam 6 in.

DO NOT DUMP IN ARROYOS! (Check
with Fire Dept.)

Monthly bill will be sent after your use of
service.
