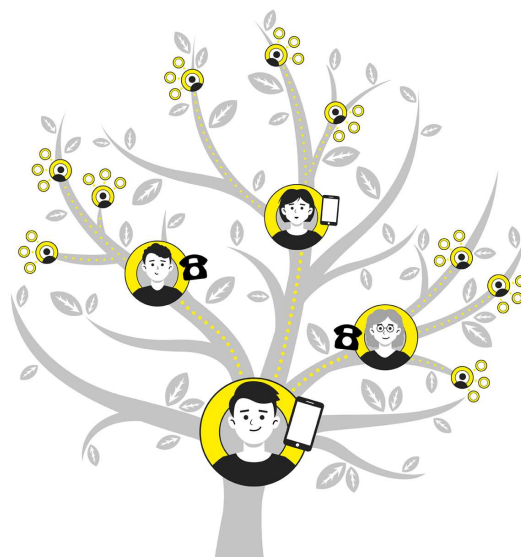
OJITOS FRIOS WILDFIRE TELEPHONE CHAIN

The HOA wildfire safety committee is trying to establish a telephone chain for the Ojitos Frios Subdivision to help ensure the safety of all who live here. The summer ahead will likely bring more threats of wildfire here in New Mexico. If a fire is started here in the subdivision, there is a chance that homeowners will not be aware of it in a timely manner.

A telephone chain will allow us to quickly alert homeowners of the presence of a wildfire within the subdivision.

How does a telephone chain work?

If a homeowner sees a wildfire in the subdivision, they will first call 911 and will then call Barbara Nash. She will start the chain calls. There will be several chains that Barbara will call to start the information being forwarded. (The number of chains will depend on the number of homeowners who wish to be on the chain.) Each chain member will have one person (below them on the chain) to call. If that person does not answer, then the next person on the chain should be called.



It's a pretty simple process.
