Hire your family, someone who knows chainsaw operation

Staging Area:

Large chipper equipment needs space near stacked material
Stacks can line road, butt ends facing out, not tangled!

Cutting and Stacking:

No limit on how much to cut or stack! So maximize this opportunity!
Follow Tierra y Montes guidelines
No longer than 8 ft.
Cut off side branches, so not wider than 4ft.
Save or give away larger trunks for firewood
No stumps or dead, dried wood

Helper(s) on Chipper Day

Be there to help pull material to the operator (1 or more helpers)

Attend Orientation prior to Chipper Day by Tierra y Montes

HOA 60 ft. Right of Way will be cleared of brush and trees on Coyote, Road Runner as part of Road Maintenance plan, 2023. Material will be chipped by Tierra y Montes.
